Sherman Elementary does not have sufficient parking or interior space. Miller Park Pavilion should be a better option with regard to parking and interior space. |

| 04-03 | Highland Tower | ICC Bowlatorium | Email | I have looked at the proposed changes for Ward 4, which is where I live and have worked several elections. I am glad that Highland Tower is back as a polling place, and having worked at both, I think KJ Tower would be a better choice than Spring Lake School, simply based on demographics. I have seen who lives at KJ Tower, many of the voters live there and have serious health issues which make it difficult for them to get out--carrying oxygen tanks, using crutches, wheelchairs, walkers, etc. There are organizations that take people to medical appointments, but these people do not take them to vote. Buried in an inside page of the Midlands section several weeks before the primary I saw a brief article that both major parties would furnish a ride for anyone who called, with telephone numbers given, but I doubt that many people saw it, or remembered it to cut it out or write down the numbers. More publicity needs to be given to this, too, but that is the parties responsibility, not yours. Spring Lake school voters mostly can get there easily--there is one blind lady in her 80s who needs help, but someone brings her and she is given assistance (she won't use the Automark). I think KJ Tower is within one block of a bus route, or even several, and I know Spring Lake school is several blocks from one. (I live a block from Spring Lake School.) While Lutheran Church of the Master - East is located within the precinct, we understand that it is not the ideal location for everyone. It has 190 parking spots available. Sunset Hills Elementary has only 35 parking spots which is insufficient for the number of voters in this precinct. |
